## **Physical and Political Map Presentation**

To better understand political and physical geography, your task is to use these skills to better understand a region of the world. You may work with one other person or by yourself, but the end product must be a presentation in front of the class.

- 1) Choose a continent (ex. Europe, Africa, Asia, etc.)
- 2) Choose a region on that continent (ex. Middle East, Central America, Southeast Asia, etc.)
- 3) Choose two countries in that region (ex. China, Nigeria, Ecuador, etc.)
- 4) Research your chosen locations and gather the information you will need for your maps, including political info (borders, country and main city names) and physical info (rivers, lakes, mountains, deserts, etc.)
  - a. Map a list of this info for your continent, region, and countries
- 5) Create a series of maps of your continent, region, and countries, by hand or using an online program (ex. <a href="www.zeemaps.com">www.zeemaps.com</a>) and programs like Paint
  - a. Political AND physical map of your continent
  - b. Political AND physical map of each of your countries
  - c. Natural Resources map of your countries
- 6) Put your maps into a PowerPoint presentation and be able to describe them to the class in detail
- 7) Give a presentation to the class showcasing your maps and what they reveal about your continent, region, and countries
